

Technical Information

Facility Requirements

The venue must have a hanging point that is deemed suitable by the Aerialista's technical director. This may be a fully exposed beam, a partially exposed beam that can hold a beam clamp or can have a hole drilled through it, or scaffolding that has been hung and tested by a professional rigger (at the venue's expense). Depending on the assessment of the Aerialista's Technical Director, a metal plate with a hanging point can be attached to the ceiling for an additional fee. A freestanding rig can be erected for outdoor events. This requires level ground with a 20'x 20'x 20' open space.

Equipment Requirements:

Any venue to be considered by the Aerialistas must meet minimum height requirements depending on the type(s) of apparatus to be used.

Hoop	18 Ft.
Rope	18 Ft.
Trapeze	20 ft.
Tissu	18 Ft.
Net	18 Ft
Anchor	18 Ft.

Performer Requirements:

All venues must provide the performers with a private changing and stretching area. Also a private bathroom is requested if possible. These areas need only to be separated from the public. Sharing with other performers and staff is acceptable. If free parking is not readily available the client must reimburse the performers and rigger for parking expenses.

Performer Fee

The Aerialistas have a minimum performance fee. The total cost depends on length, number of performers, and the type of show the client is requesting. Additional fees may be applied if travel is required or if customized costumes are requested. **Call or Emil for an estimate.**

Rigging Fee

All venues must be assessed before hand to determine the safety and feasibility of the hanging point(s). There is a minimum cost for the assessment due at the time of inspection. If the space is deemed fit this fee will be applied toward the total rigging cost.
